- It is acceptable to bring animals inside the Exhibit Hall (dogs/rabbits/ etc), but please only if they are house-trained or in a kennel during the event.






Sheridan County 4-H now has a Shutterfly Photo-Sharing site!! Please go check it out today!

Only members of Sheridan County 4-H will be granted access to this site.



#### FOR EXISTING MEMBERS

- I. Go to http://wy.4honline.com You will see a screen like this.
- 2. As an existing Member/Family that is re-enrolling for the next
- 4-H year select the first option O Thave a profile
- Enter your email address and password you used to create your Family login and click the button
- enter your email address and click the Gend My Password button.
- · A new automated password will be sent to the email address you provided along with instructions to login and reset your password.
  - Once you are logged in you can review your Family info and update it if needed by clicking the Edit Family button
  - 4. In the MEMBER LIST tab, please look at the Member/Volunteer List to view the members/adult volunteers associated with your family account.

Please do not add a new individual that is already listed in the member/volunteer list!

  - You will be taken to the project tab where you can add or delete projects.





   Click the Submit Enrollment Button.


Once you have Submitted an Enrollment you will then be taken back to the **MEMBER LIST** screen

You can then enroll new 4-H Members or Volunteers using the same steps.

Your enrollment will be sent to the County Extension Office where they will review and approve/activate your profile, or return your enrollment to you for changes/additional information.











#### Attention Leaders!!!

All new leaders and leaders who are in their 5th year and need to be re-screened are now required to complete training requirements before they will be screened and approved as a 4-H volunteer leader.

A **NEW** leader is required to complete two training pieces; in any order:

- 1. The Volunteer e-Learning modules accessible from the State 4-H website. http://www.uwyo.edu/4-h/
  The password is volunteer.
- 2. The face-to-face New Leader Orientation, which is completed by Liz.

A volunteer leader in their **5th YEAR** is required to complete a training that will benefit their role as a 4-H volunteer.




