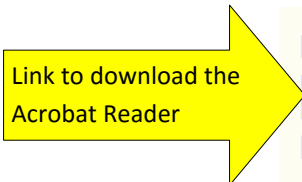

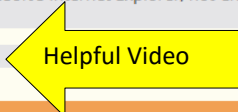
*You most likely will need to install Adobe Acrobat Reader DC (free) on your computer in order to view/save/use the Portfolio pages.*

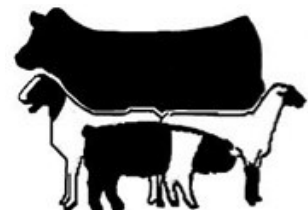

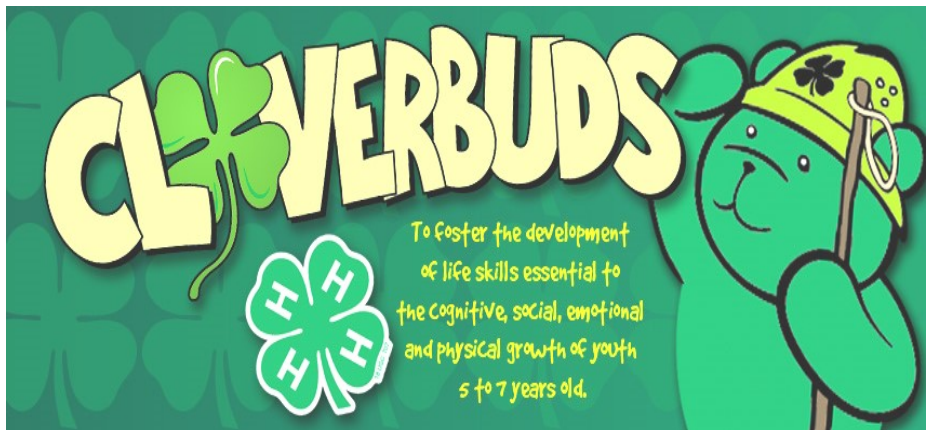


**Cloverbuds** is an exploratory program for youth 5-7 years old who are interested in 4-H.

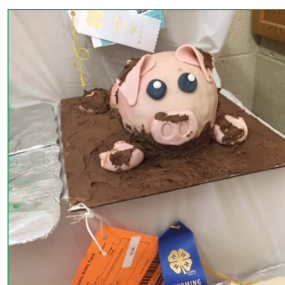

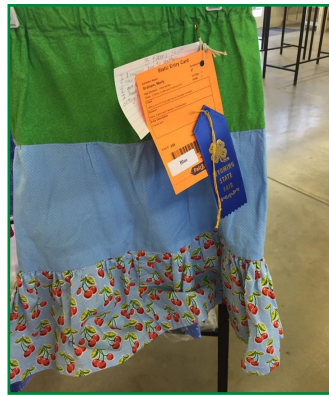
