


### Sheridan County 4-H

Youth selling market animals must complete a YQA class level corresponding to their age divisions.





Have you ever wanted to dig deeper into breeding and showing rabbits? Do you want to learn about all the different breeds of rabbits? Do you want to know the whys and hows of placing a class of rabbits? Do you NEED to know more than basic rabbit showmanship skills?

If so then the Wyoming 4-H Rabbit Judging Team wants you to join us for learning, fun, and competition.

We compete in 4-H rabbit judging competitions in Colorado through the spring and then compete nationally at the National ARBA Convention each year. Throughout the year you are provided the necessary materials to learn all the ins and outs of how to judge rabbits, and to improve your showmanship presentation. The team consists of a group of youth from across the entire state of Wyoming.

We meet weekly for one hour virtually (online) and then gather up 4 or 5 times a spring to compete in Colorado.
