### SHAVINGS

Each member has access to the bunk of loose clean shavings

Bring a flat scoop shovel to clean your pens and a wheelbarrow or muck cart

Exhibitors MUST keep pens clean at all times.

Dirty pens will be flagged for immediate attention.

Stalls and pens must be cleaned no later than **9 am daily**.

## CHECK-IN Static Exhibits

- Check-in table will be on the north side of the Exhibit Hall behind the building near the grandstands. This is the opposite of years past. Front doors will be locked
- Attach Exhibit Entry Tags BEFORE arrival. Tags are in your Fair Packet
- Arrive at the Exhibit Hall 30 minutes before your scheduled interview time slot
- Check in with the volunteer outside so we know you are here
- Please wait outside until you are called back for your interview
- No Drop Off exhibits allowed. These will not be judged. Exhibitors must be present for their interview for a project to be judged.
- Judges will be available to judge exhibits in the hall only during scheduled interview times.
- No late 4-H exhibits will be judged after designated cut-off times for any project area
- Parents may not enter the Exhibit Hall during interviews
- Additionally, there will be a Champion Interview award given in each age division.
- The Exhibit Hall will NOT be available for public viewing until 4 pm, Tuesday, July 29th.
- The judges' scores are final.



- Dog, Cat, Horse, and Pocket Pet will check in at their show (Cat MUST bring vaccination record)
- Livestock must check in at the gate prior to entering the stalling area
- Market lambs and Market goats must be slick shorn (no blankets, tubes, or muzzles)
- · Hogs must be clean of mud
- Weigh Ins Wednesday July 30th:
  - o 6:00 am -8:00 am Market Beef, Market Heifers, and Breeding Heifer Weigh-In
  - o 9:00 am -12:00 pm Market Goats/Market Lamb Weigh-In
  - o 1:00 -4:00 pm Swine move in and set up. In place by 4 pm
  - 4:00 -7:00 pm Market Swine Weigh-In (Swine staying on site)
  - 7:00 -8:00 pm Market Swine Weigh-In (Show & Go Swine)
- You may only weigh in at your designated time(s) for your species
- No livestock may arrive before Wednesday at 4 pm, with the exception of Dairy Cattle and Dairy Goats
- Beef and Sheep MUST bring brand inspection papers
- You MUST check-in with your species superintendent upon your arrival AND before leaving (even if you are in a feeder class)
- Stall assignments are in your Fair Packet
- If you specified that you will be "showing out of a trailer" on your ownership paperwork, there will NOT be a stall for you

### SILENT AUCTION Participation Details

- Any project that receives a red ribbon or better is eligible to be sold in the silent auction.
- Exhibitors must fill out a silent auction information sheet.
- Silent auction information sheets must be turned in to a Indoor Committee member by the Thursday immediately following interview judging.
- Items sold through Silent Auction will go to the Extension Office.
- Highest bidders will be contacted and invoiced through the office.
- Members selling baked goods or fresh produce MUST deliver their product to the buyer no later than Sept. 1st.
- Bidder payment is due to the Extension Office no later than Sept. 1st.
- Thank You notes to Silent Auction buyers MUST be delivered to the Extension Office NO LATER than Sept. 1st.
- Failure to comply with Thank You note expectations will cause the exhibitor to forfeit proceeds from silent auction sale.
- MUST BE 18 years old to bid.






