The Meeting was called to order at 6:02pm by Chairman Justin West at the Extension Office on 01.04.23.

Approval of the consent agenda:

- Approval of minutes from the last meeting (sent out via email)
- Project area meeting dates and time (sent out via email)
- Sale Committee Checking Account Balance: \$14,603.69.
 - Tony moved to approve the consent agenda and Katie 2nd, motion carried.

Old Business:
