1. Currently enrolled member in the 4-H Shooting Sports Program in Sweetwater County.
2. Graduating from high school the year of application.
3. Must be an active member in the 4-H Shooting Sports Program in Sweetwater County for a minimum of 3 years and completed the project all 3 years by attending the County Shoot.

For applicant to be considered for this scholarship he/she MUST submit the following additional items along with this application:

1. A 250-500 word essay describing how 4-H shooting sports has affected your life, what you have learned and ALL 4-H activities in which you have participated. (See page 2 of this application)
2. Two (2) letters of recommendation. (Cannot be from a 4-H Shooting Sports Leader)
3. Current high school transcript & a copy of their ACT Score.

1. Presentation of the award will be made to the recipient by the Key Leader of the 4-H Shooting Sports Program.
2. The Scholarship award will be in the form of a check made payable to the institution following proof of enrollment for the fall semester of the current year, to an accredited college, technical or vocational institute.
