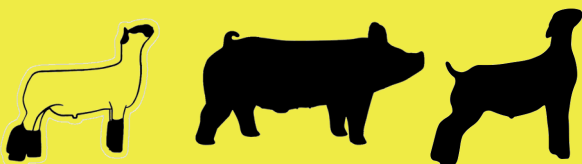

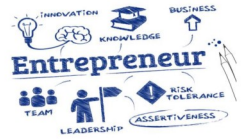

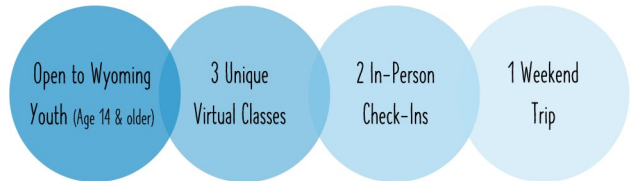
WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO BE AN ENTREPRENEUR?

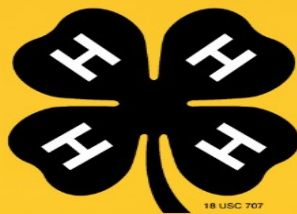
