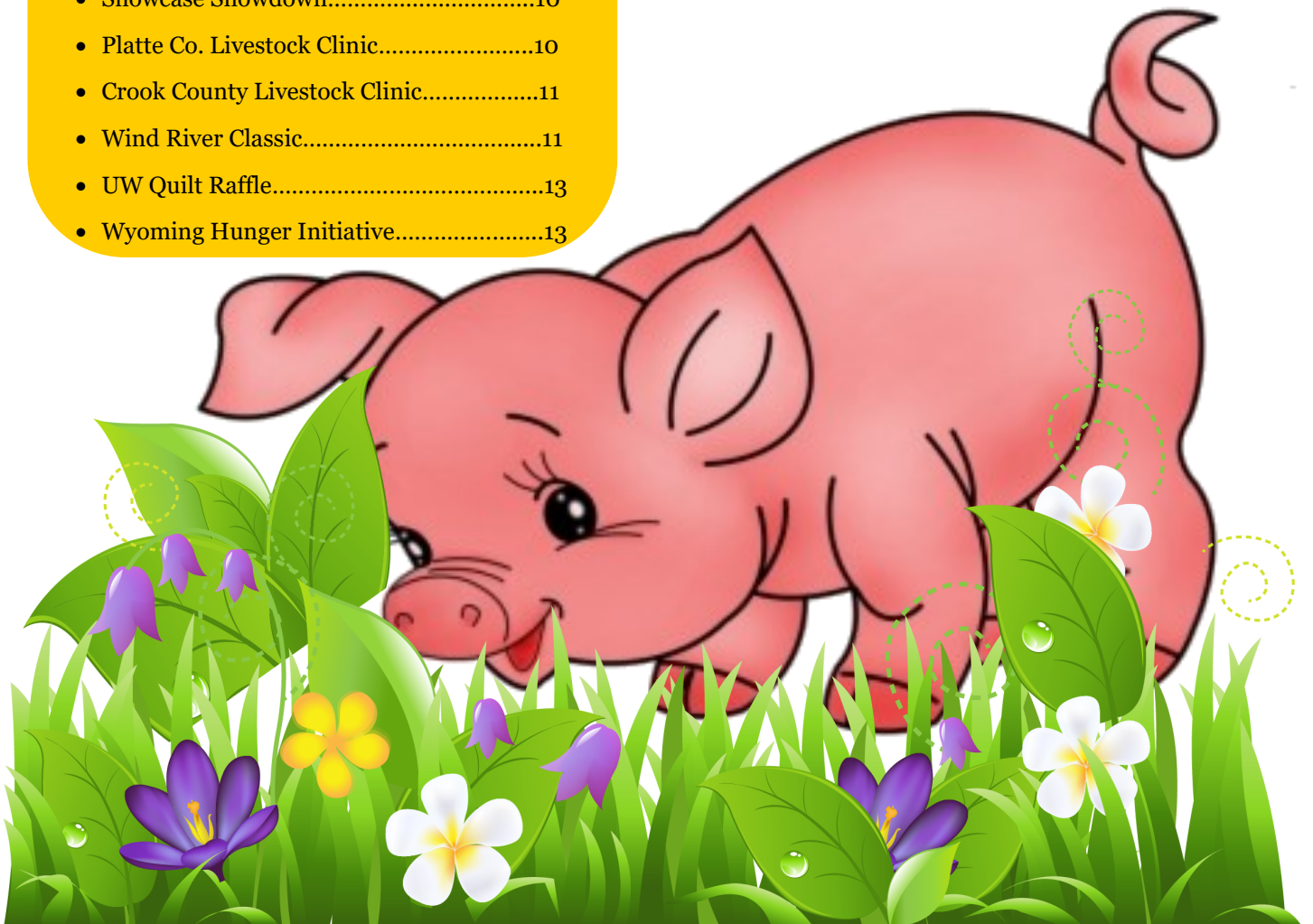

Horse Safety Certification/ Ownership Deadline

All horses (owned or leased)need to be safety certified by July 1st. Safety certification is required for each horse that a member plans to compete with in the Sweetwater County Fair Youth Horse Show.

Tagging Deadline

Swine, Sheep and Goat Ownership/Tagging deadline is June 1st. Tags are available for pick-up at the Extension Office. Member needs to be enrolled in 4-H and have dues paid before tags will be given. Animal information and pictures will need to be uploaded into ZSuites by 4-H Member before the June 1st. Deadline.

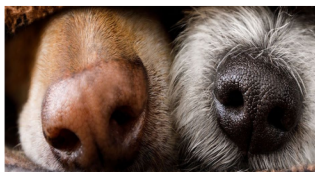
