Reignite 4-H (November 3-5, 2023): Leader, Volunteer and Educator Training available in Cheyenne, WY. Please call the extension office for mor information or see page 8.

Ignite by 4-H (March 13-17, 2024): Join us in D.C. for a 4-day experience where high-school aged teens connect, make memories and find their spark by exploring the best 4-H has to offer in STEM, Agriscience, Healthy Living, Career Readiness and Emotional Well-being. All Wyoming 4-H members age 14 and older are eligible to apply. Participants are chosen using an application and interview process. Applications will be available in October 2023, and will be due January 8, 2024.

National 4-H Conference (April 19 - 24, 2024): The 2024 National 4-H Conference information will be released in the fall. This is the US Secretary of Agricultures premier youth development opportunity. Young people assist in the development recommendations to help 4-H YOuth Development programs nationally and in thei communities. All Wyoming 4-H members age 15 and older are eligible to apply. Participants are chosen using an application and interview process. Applications will be available Mid-October 2023, and will be due January 31, 2024.

ShowCase Showdown (Tenatively scheduled to be held June 18-20, 2024): Offers an opportunity for youth to explore various industries through contests and workshops.

Wyoming State Shoot (July 11-14, 2024): The 2024 Wyoming State Shoot is tentatively scheduled to be held July 11-14 2024 in Douglas, Wyoming.

Sweetwater County Fair (July 27 - August 4, 2024): The 2024 Wyoming's Big Show
