opportunity to try it out this October and see if you're ready to Ready, Set, Explore!



PUMPKIN RAISIN BREAD

recipe found at: https://uwyocnp.org/pumpkin-raisin-bread

Ingredients

- 1½ cup whole-wheat flour
- ½ cup brown sugar
- 1 teaspoon cinnamon
- · 1 teaspoon pumpkin pie spice
- 1 teaspoon salt
- ½ teaspoon baking soda
- 1 cup canned pumpkin
- ½ cup raisins
- ¼ cup non-fat vanilla Greek yogurt
- ¼ cup unsweetened applesauce
- 2 egg whites



Directions

- 1. Preheat oven to 350°F.
- In two separate bowls, mix dry, and then wet ingredients. Then combine, adding wet to dry and stirring gently until the mixture is uniform.
- 3. Depending on if you are making bread or muffins, either spoon the mixture into a non-stick muffin tray or a bread pan.
- 4. Bake muffins for 25 minutes, or loaf of bread for 75 minutes.
